FCPS Online Campus Classes

Students may take 1 or 2 classes through the Online Campus each year. Online classes are held synchronously via Zoom after school hours; attendance in class is required. McLean HS students taking a class through the Online Campus as one of their 7 allotted school year courses will either arrive to school late or leave school early to accommodate the shortened schedule during the school day. Transportation will not be provided. Preference for late arrival or early dismissal should be shared with the student's school counselor and will be considered, but cannot be guaranteed pending space availability and if the schedule allows. If the Online Campus class is an 8th course (i.e. the student is taking a full schedule of 7 credit bearing courses at McLean High School), there will be a fee of \$680 for the additional course, which will be billed by the Online Campus after the class begins.
