Students may take 1 or 2 classes through the Online Campus each year. Online classes are held synchronously via Zoom after school hours; attendance in class is required. McLean HS students taking a class through the Online Campus as one of their 7 allotted school year courses will either arrive to school late or leave school early to accommodate the shortened schedule during the school day.
