Dual Enrollment Eligibility

- To be eligible for Dual Enrollment Courses, students must demonstrate college readiness.
- There are two ways students can meet the admissions criteria for a Dual Enrollment class:
- Option 1 - GPA, PSAT, SAT, or ACT scores (PRIMARY WAY TO QUALIFY!)
- Option 2 - VPT Scores (If student does not qualify with GPA or available test scores)

Part 1: Apply to NOVA

The application process is free and must be completed online. After you submit the application online, you will receive a 7 digit EMPLID number, username and temporary password to set up your myNOVA account.

- Select APPLY NOW (OR CONTINUE APPLICATION) (highlighted in green box)
- In the bottom gray box, select CREATE AN ACCOUNT
- Enter your name, date of birth, cell phone (if you have one).
- Enter your PERSONAL email address - Use a valid and active email account **(DO NOT use your FCPS email account)**
- You will receive an account validation sent your personal email. Check email for code.
- Create a username & password; these credentials are used only for this application. Write down your temporary login and password.
- Select a security question and answer.
- Select “High School/Guidance Counselor” in Additional Information question.
- Check the box for “I have read and agree to the privacy policy and terms of use of this site.”

Step 1. THE BASICS

- Name: Enter your current, complete legal name. No nicknames, please.
- Former Name: This applies only if you have legally changed your name.
- Social Security Number: If you have one, fill it in here. Otherwise, you don't have to provide it at this time.
- Have you ever applied, attended, or worked at any community college in Virginia? **Select NO**

Step 2. COMMUNICATING WITH YOU

- Have you lived in Virginia for the last twelve months – **Select YES or NO.**
 - If NO, select the state or county of your previous residence. Tip: Selecting NO may mean that you are not eligible for In-State Tuition
- If you plan to apply for financial assistance, Federal Financial Aid guidelines requires NOVA to obtain your voluntary consent to use electronic means, to provide you with information. Financial aid is not required for dual enrollment but if you plan to attend NOVA after graduation you will need to **select: I AGREE AND HAVE REVIEWED THE GUIDELINES**

Step 3. YOUR EDUCATION

- Which of the below describes your current high school education? **Select: I am currently attending a public/private high school in a U.S state, territory, or military installation**
- High School Information: Click on **FIND SCHOOL** and type in the high school you are attending using the search function. **Select school and choose ADD School**
- Enter your expected high school graduation date (month and year):
 - If you are currently a junior, **select 06/2026**
 - If you are currently a sophomore, **select 06/2027**
 - If you are currently a freshman, **select 06/2028**
- You do not need to upload your transcript.
- Have you attended any other colleges? **Select NO**

 - I plan to earn a degree, certificate or diploma: **Select Yes (if you plan to attend NOVA after graduation) or Select NO (if you have plans other than NOVA after graduation)**

- Pick a primary campus location: **Choose the NOVA campus nearest to your home**

Step 4. YOUR MILITARY SERVICE

- Have you served or are you currently serving in the U.S. military? Select: **No**

Step 5. YOUR BACKGROUND

- Parent(s) Education Level: Use the dropdown menus to enter your parent's highest education. This information is collected for statistical purposes only.
- **Residency: Your status is not considered for dual enrolled classes in the high school.**
 - Native – you have been a U.S. citizen since birth.
 - Naturalized– you became a U.S. citizen after birth.
 - Permanent resident – you will need to fill in your resident#, status and your country of citizenship.
 - Currently in the U.S as a Non-Immigrant – you will need to choose a visa type and country of citizenship.
 - You may apply for in-state tuition based on your own domicile or your spouse's domicile:
Select: **I want to claim using my parent's domicile (address)**

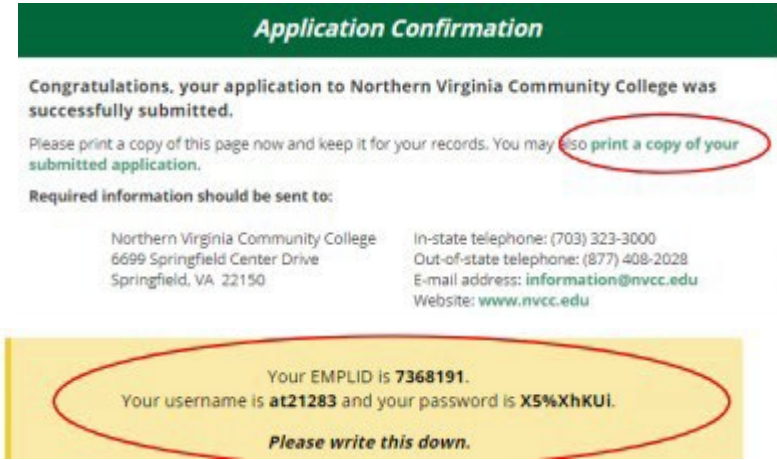
- Your Domicile Information: ***All Dual Enrollment students taking classes for that semester at their high school will receive in-state tuition regardless of their domicile information.**
 - Students whose domicile application information results in out-of-state status will be given an exception for in-state tuition for that current semester only.
 - Every student is in-state for purposes of dual enrollment.

Step 6. IDENTITY VERIFICATION

- NOVA requires all applicants to verify their identity through the ID Verification Process with a real time photo of yourself and submitted photo ID (Learner's Permit, Driver's License, Passport, etc.)
- If you complete the application **at your school using the school's Wi-Fi**, then you will be **exempt** from this process.
- If you complete the application **at home**, you will **need** to complete the ID Verification Process
- You will be prompted to start the verification process. **Click "Verify Identity"**. A new tab will open. **Click "Next"**.
- A Liveness Check and Photo ID are required for the process. **Click "Start"**
- The privacy statement from NOVA's partner, Mitek, is displayed. **Click "Agree and Continue"**
- **Click "Liveness Check"**. Follow the on-screen instructions to take a selfie. This can also be completed on a mobile device using the "Use your mobile phone" link.
- Once your Liveness Check is complete, **Click "Add Identity Document"**. Select your desired document type you wish to upload.
- Follow the on-screen instructions to upload the Front and Back of the photo ID. This can also be completed on a mobile device using the "Use your mobile phone" link.
- After the Liveness Check and Photo ID are completed, return to the college application to submit.

Step 7. SUBMIT

- Select **SUBMIT YOUR COMPLETED APPLICATION**
- The application may take **a few minutes** to process.
- After you submit your application, you will receive confirmation that your application has been submitted successfully with the college and term information (example below).



Make sure to write down, take a picture, or save a screenshot of your EMPLID ID, you will need it for Part 2 of the process.

DE students are NOT required to print, sign, and submit a copy of the application.

All students under the age of 18 must have their parent or guardian sign their application for admission. Please print your application confirmation and have your parent/guardian sign below. Then return your signed form to the college admissions office.

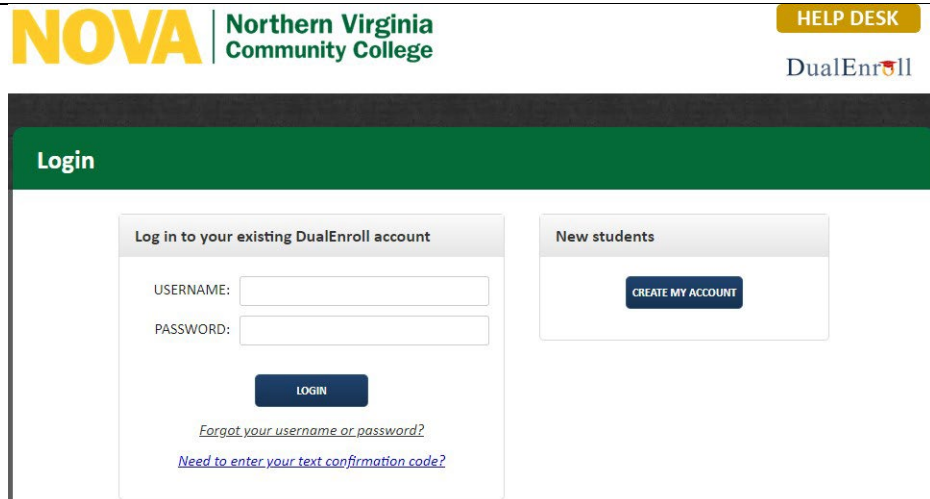
NEW DE Students - Part 2: Dual Enroll Portal Class Registration

Create your dualenroll.com account and register for your DE class(es).

Go to: <https://tinyurl.com/deportal>

1. Select “Create My Account” under New Students.

***DO NOT** use the myNOVA username and temporary password you received at the completion of the NOVA application. These systems are not connected.



2. Select your high school. Create a **NEW** login and password. Enter your legal name, date of birth, email, and cell phone number. You **must** use your **personal email address** to receive a verification code and activate your account.

*****Do not** use your parent’s email or cell phone number for this part. You may also enter your phone number to receive a verification code to activate your account.

3. Verify your account first from your email or text message before logging in. A verification code will be sent.

4. Complete setting up your account and enter your 7-digit NOVA EMPLID. You received your EMPLID after you completed the NOVA application successfully. **(Do not use your FCPS Student ID!)**

5. Check the box to agree to terms and conditions.

6. Enter your parent/legal guardian name and contact information. Select a preferred communication method (text or email). **Text is preferred!** You parent/legal guardian will receive a notification to provide consent. Please make sure they provide consent.

7. Select your high school counselor. Then, enter your FCPS student ID number. Finally, click on ‘Finish’ to complete your account set up.

8. Once your account is set up, you you will see the “Courses” page. This page will list the DE classes available to you for registration.

9. In the top lefthand corner, locate “By Term” that is written in red. Click the drop down and select “FY 2025-2026 – Northern Virginia Community College”. This will allow you to see what is being offered for the 25-26 school year.

- 10.** Using the next 2 pages of the packet (**pages 12-13**), locate the DE class(es) you would like to take. The first column has the FCPS course title, and the second column has the matching NOVA course. You will be selecting the NOVA class here, not the FCPS course title.
- 11.** Click on the course title of the NOVA class that matches the course code of the DE class you would like to take.
- 12.** You will be taken to a new page where you will click “Register” on the row that indicates where you will be taking the class – at your school, at an Academy, or at the Online Campus, IF applicable. Make sure you register for the correct location!
- 13.** After you click “Register” for your class, you will be asked if you would like to “Request Another Class, View Status, or Log Out”.
-If you have to select another class, click on “Request another class” and register for the correct class and location.
- 14.** Your parent/guardian will receive a text message or email to provide their consent for you to take a DE class. PLEASE ensure this gets completed! NOVA will NOT register you for your class unless you have parental consent!

Thank you for requesting to take a dual enrollment (DE) course through Northern Virginia Community College (NOVA). All dual enrolled students wishing to use accommodations for the Virginia Placement Test (VPT) or in a NOVA DE course must complete an application through the Accommodations and Accessibility Services at NOVA. To learn more about this process and to submit the online application, you can visit <https://www.nvcc.edu/student-resources/accessibility/process.html>. **The best window of time to apply is between April 15, 2025 and June 1, 2025 to be processed by the first day of DE classes in the fall.** However, students can apply anytime.

It's important to note that students using accommodations in dual enrollment classes must provide their DE instructors with a **Memorandum of Accommodations (MOA)**, which they obtain from NOVA's Accommodations and Accessibility Services office. No accommodations can be made for a student until the MOA has been provided to the DE instructor. All email correspondence from this office will be sent to the student's NOVA student email, which can be accessed by logging into [myNOVA](#). Please note, NOVA recognizes the student as the primary point of contact, and approved accommodations are valid for one semester.

Students should be aware that NOVA is in compliance with Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and the Americans with Disabilities Act Amendments Act (ADAAA) of 2008 and not all accommodations on IEP and 504 Plans will be approved within the college classroom. Students choosing to use accommodations provided by the high school without seeking an MOA from NOVA's Accommodations and Accessibility Services will be unable to have them applied to the college grade.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- You must apply to NOVA prior to registering for accommodations at <https://apply.vccs.edu/oa/launch.action>
- To apply for accommodations, visit the Accommodations and Accessibility Services website: <https://www.nvcc.edu/student-resources/accessibility/index.html>
- Click on the “Apply for Accommodations” button, and log in using your myNOVA/SIS username and password (MFA – Multifactor Authenticator required).
 - Select “student” as user type
 - Complete all application fields.
 - Please use your NOVA student email address (____@email.vccs.edu) if you have registered for at least one course. If not, please enter your personal email address, that will be used temporarily.

- Documentation can be submitted at the time of application or later.
 - To upload documentation from your accommodations profile, navigate to “Accommodations” on the left-hand panel and then select “Documents.”
 - Click the “Add New Document” button and submit your documentation.
- Once an application has been reviewed, you will be contacted by a counselor within 14 business days.
