**PSAT & SAT School Day
Wednesday, October 12**

Freshman: **Wednesday, October 12**

- **9th grade students will NOT report to the school building in person on October 12th.**
- FCPS will not be taking attendance this day for 9th graders. Teachers are not expected to provide work for students to complete.

Sophomores & Juniors: **Wednesday, October 12**

- All sophomores and juniors will take the PSAT on October 12th at no cost.
- It is expected that 10th and 11th grade students attend school this day.
- For grade 10 students, taking the PSAT/NMSQT provides students with practice.
- Students in grade 11 are eligible for the National Merit Scholarship based on their scores.

Seniors: **Wednesday, October 12**

- Seniors who opt in can take the SAT School Day on October 12, free of charge.
- Seniors who would like to take the SAT School Day on October 12th must complete the intent form by September 7th at <https://tinyurl.com/McLeanSAT2022> (using their school Google account). This link can also be found in the Class of 2023 Schoology group and in an e-Notify email to families.
- Students who do not complete the intent form by September 7th, will not be able to test on October 12th due to College Board deadlines.
- Note that scores from the October 12 SAT School-Day will not be back in time for November 1st college application deadlines.

Things to Know: PSAT/ SAT School Day Testing

- PSAT/SAT School Day administration begins in the morning, and students are expected to arrive to their testing rooms by 8:00 AM.
- High school academy courses are not held on October 12.
- This will be a 2 hour early release day for students with standard testing time.
- FCPS transportation is available to all students.
- Breakfast and lunch will be available to purchase for students.
- Students should leave all electronic devices such as mobile phones, smart watches, tablets, or other wearable technology at home or in their vehicles. They are not permitted in the testing rooms.
- Students should bring the following: a photo ID, number 2 pencils, a graphing calculator, a peanut-free snack (optional), a drink or water bottle. We are not able to loan out pencils or calculators
- Students should check their FCPS Gmail frequently for additional information regarding testing on October 12th.
