and PSAT

Seniors: **Wednesday, October 13**

Optional School-Day SAT @ McLean High School

- Seniors who opt in can take the School-Day SAT on October 13, free of charge.
- Seniors who would like to take the School Day SAT on October 13th must complete the intent form by **September 8th** at <https://tinyurl.com/McLeanSAT2021> (using their school Google account). This link can also be found in the Class of 2022 Schoology group and in an e-Notify email to families.
- Students who do not complete the intent form by September 8th, will not be able to test on October 13th due to College Board deadlines.
- Note that scores from the October 13 School-Day SAT will not be back in time for November 1st college application deadlines.

Wednesday, October 13

PSAT @ McLean High School

- All sophomores and juniors will take the PSAT on October 13th at no cost.
- Students in grade 11 are eligible to compete for the National Merit Scholarship based on their scores.
- For grade 10 students, taking the PSAT/NMSQT in provides students with practice.

Freshmen: Wednesday, October 13

FCPS will announce the plan for freshmen soon.

- Ninth grade students do not take the PSAT.
- Please stay tuned: FCPS plans for ninth grade students on October 13 will be announced soon.

Things to Know: PSAT/SAT School-Day Testing

- PSAT/SAT School Day administration begins in the morning, according to regular school start times.
- High school academy courses are *not* held on October 13.
- FCPS transportation is available to all students.
- Breakfast and lunch will be provided for students.
- Students should wear a mask.
- Students should leave all electronic devices such as mobile phones, smart watches, tablets, or other wearable technology at home or in their vehicles. They are not permitted in the testing rooms.
- Students should bring the following: a photo ID, number 2 pencils, a graphing calculator, a peanut-free snack (optional), a drink or water bottle. We are not able to loan out pencils or calculators to students due to health concerns.
- Students should check their FCPS Gmail frequently for additional information regarding testing on October 13th.
