# Rising Sophomores

- **Typical Sophomore Year Schedule**
  - English
  - World History
  - Math
  - Science
  - Physical Education
  - World Language
  - Electives
- Pick 2 alternates in case your first choices are full



All students will meet individually with their counselor to finalize their selections.

- Rising sophomores will meet with counselors through their PE class between January 17 – February 1.
- Rising seniors will meet with counselors through their history class between February 2 – February 16.
- Rising juniors will meet with counselors through their PE class between February 20 – March 2.
