9th Grade Course Options



- 1. English 9 or English 9 HN
- 2. World History 1 or World History 1 HN
- 3. Math (see next slide for details)
- 4. Biology 1 or Biology 1 HN
- 5. Health and PE 9
- 6. World Language or Elective
- 7. Elective

*Be sure to pick 2 alternative electives in addition to your 7 classes above!

Math Class Sequence

The initial math class sequence in FCPS is: Algebra 1 -> Geometry -> Algebra 2

For 9th grade, students should select:

- Algebra 1: If a high school math class has not yet been taken
- **Geometry:** If currently enrolled in Algebra 1
- **Algebra 2:** If currently enrolled in Geometry
- **Higher math:** If currently enrolled in Algebra 2

Registration Process Timeline

Now: Gather information and start considering initial course selections

[January 11th-12th]: McLean Counselors will be at Longfellow to orient rising 9th graders with info and course options

[Starting Jan 19th - Feb 2nd]: Longfellow counselors will begin meeting with rising 9th graders (please have all initial selections made in StudentVue prior to seeing your counselor)

[March 6th]: From this date forward, scheduling questions should be directed to McLean counselors

*Registrations for students transferring from outside of FCPS will begin in March
