McLean High School is thrilled to continue the tradition of the Highlander Internship Program for graduating seniors this year. The program lets eligible seniors intern in local businesses, schools, and community service organizations. These internships will benefit selected students in numerous ways. It will help them explore a possible area of interest for college and provide tangible experience putting academic interests in action in non-academic settings. It may also provide an opportunity for students to give time and effort to service organizations that need both.
